The destruction of the "jungle" camp by French authorities has not ended the refugee crisis. It has worsened conditions for refugees, including unaccompanied children. The British government has failed to carry out its responsibilities to refugees. It has taken only a fraction of the unaccompanied refugee children agreed to under the Dubs amendment.

call on Theresa May to act responsibility and take in the 3,000 child refugees suggested by Alf Dubs – himself a survivor of the Holocaust thanks to the Kindertransport.
