On Monday 27 March, the #IllegalMigrationBill – Sunak and Braverman’s latest brutal attack on the human rights of refugees – is to be read in Parliament.

Care4Calais and Stand Up To Racism are opposing the bill, and supporting an amendment for a safe passage visa scheme that would enable those exercising their internationally and legally recognised human right to seek asylum to travel safely to Britain in order to pursue their asylum claim.

The government’s new bill is yet another vicious assault on the rights of refugees and is about whipping up racist division to scapegoat refugees and migrants.
