

REFORM UK IS A RACIST PARTY



Nigel Farage's Reform UK party is a danger to us all. Don't vote for it.



It whips up racism against refugees, migrants and Muslims. But it also threatens everyone except the very rich elite. Farage, a millionaire private school boy, wants to rip up the NHS and opposes new rights for workers.

Reform UK is a fraud. It says it is anti-establishment but helps out the enemies of working class people. It wants you to blame migrants and refugees for the problems in Britain while it protects the super-rich who are grabbing more and more.

Don't be fooled. Racism means violence, hatred and division. It also distracts attention from the people at the top who fill their pockets while we fight one another.

Reform UK is getting more racist and launching new attacks on working class people as it grows.

After a big internal row, Farage and his henchmen agreed with new Runcorn and Helsby MP Sarah Pochin to push for a ban on the Muslim burqa.

Reform UK's first act in the councils it grabbed in the May elections was to attack LGBT+ pride events, to look for Trump-style attacks on services and to savage council workers' pay and pensions.

Speaking about council workers, Richard Tice, the party's deputy leader, said "We're going to have to go to war with these people."

When people campaign together against Reform UK they can push back against its division, hatred and lies. We can work for a better future for all of us. Choose progress and unity. Don't vote Reform UK.

Riddled with racists

Farage went to school at the posh private Dulwich College. One member of staff described Farage and other students “shouting Hitler youth songs”. A Jewish pupil remembered Farage saying, “Hitler was right!” and “Gas ‘em!”.

In 2014 he said that “parts of Britain are now unrecognisable and look like a foreign land” because of migration.

Farage also said in 2014, “Any normal person would have a perfect right to be concerned if a group of Romanian people suddenly moved in next door.”

During the 2024 general election, Farage suggested Muslims in Britain “do not subscribe to British values”.

Reform UK winning five MPs at the general election came just before the far right riots and the fierce attacks on mosques and hotels where refugees were housed.

Reform UK is riddled with racism, sexism, homophobia and bigotry.

Farage wants to wreck the NHS

In an interview on LBC radio this year he said he was “open to anything” when it comes to replacing the present health service with “an insurance-based model”.

Migrants helped to build our NHS. Reform UK’s policies are set to destroy it. Its general election manifesto laid out £50 billion of cuts to the NHS, the education system and social care.

Friends of the bosses

All of Reform UK’s MPs voted against improving workers’ rights. Soon after they were elected, they had to decide whether to support a bill that improved sick pay and leave for new parents. It also made it harder for bosses to sack workers and re-employ them on lower pay and worse conditions. Led by Farage, they all voted against it.

Super-rich Farage

Between his election as an MP in July 2024 and the 1 May 2025—a period of less than a year—Farage pocketed over £1 million from “outside interests” on top of his bloated £94,000 a year MP’s pay.

One of his latest gigs was £25,000 from Rupert Murdoch’s Australian media company New Corp—for 19 hours “work”.

His most lucrative payout is working as a TV presenter on GB News. This paid him £331,394 in ten months. But Farage’s best paid side-hustle is flogging gold as a tax-free investment for Direct Bullion. This has earned him £280,500 for a maximum of 24 hours of work, or £11,700 an hour.
