**Imagine the Premier League without players like Bukayo Saka, Morgan Rogers or Mo Salah. Imagine the WSL without the likes of Khadija Shaw, Melvin Malard and Michelle Agyemang.**

Imagine what a “decolonised” Manchester United team owned by tax exile Jim Ratcliffe would look like.

Football fans across the country know the joy of seeing players from around the world combining to score a goal and uniting to keep a clean sheet. At its best, football teams are a great example of people from across the globe working together as equals. Just imagine what it would be without that unity.

That’s what things would be like if fascists, the far right and political parties like Reform UK got their way. These organisations are trying to spread hatred by scapegoating refugee and migrant communities. If fascists like Tommy Robinson or populists like Nigel Farage had their way we would see Trump style raids and mass deportations in Britain.

But it doesn’t stop there. If they had their way, we wouldn’t just see an end to immigration. The far right fantasise about “re-migration” – deporting people with black and brown skins who were born in this country.

That would mean *deporting* the likes of Jude Bellingham, Reece and Lauren James and Marc Guehi and Jess Carter. If these racists and fascists we’re in power, there would be no WSL and no Lionesses team. Instead women players – many of whom are rightly out and proud about their sexuality – would be banished to the closet and the kitchen.

Racists and the far right offer nothing but violence and division to our communities and nothing to our game. That’s why we say: Kick the fascists, far right and racists out of football!
